PLAINTIFFS' MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE EXHIBITS UNDER SEAL

Pursuant to Local Rule 5.2, Plaintiffs seek leave to file Exhibits F and G to the Plaintiffs' Response in Opposition to Walgreens's Objection to Modified Discovery Ruling No. 23 ("Plaintiffs' Opposition").

Local Rule 5.2 states: "No document will be accepted for filing under seal unless a statute, court rule, or prior court order authorizes the filing of sealed documents." Loc. R. 5.2. Exhibits F and G to Plaintiffs' Opposition contain information that has been subject to Protective and Confidentiality Orders, including Case Management Order No. 2 and the amendment thereto (ECF Nos. 441 & 1357). This information is subject to this Court's Order Amending Procedures Regarding Redactions and Filing of Briefs Under Seal (ECF No. 1813).

Plaintiffs do not believe the information warrants remaining under seal but seek to comply with all applicable Orders concerning information that has been marked or designated as confidential.

Plaintiffs respectfully request to proceed in this manner so there are no inadvertent disclosures of information subject to Protective and Confidentiality Orders and to comply with this Court's orders.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiffs respectfully request the Honorable Court to grant Plaintiffs' Motion for Leave to File Exhibits Under Seal and to direct Defendants to indicate within three (3) business days whether they will assert any redactions.
